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School Profile

Kokomo High School is proud of its culturally-diverse student body of approximately 1,500 students in grades 9-12, including roughly 90 international students each school year. Since 2012, more than 350 International students representing more than 25 countries have elected to study at Kokomo High School. KHS students learn from each other while experiencing a rigorous and engaging curriculum through a variety of challenging academic programs, as well as co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. The student body is 35% minority: 6.7% Hispanic, 2% Asian, 16.5% African American, and 10.1% multiracial. Roughly 55% of the students are part of the free/reduced lunch program.

The faculty consists of 104 certified faculty members, 60% of whom have been teaching for 10 or more years. The school year consists of 180 days divided into two semesters. The school day has 7 periods each lasting 50 minutes.

Curriculum

Kokomo High School's 24 Advanced Placement (AP) courses rival any high school in Indiana, and KHS is authorized as a World School in the International Baccalaureate (IB) Middle Years Program, IB Diploma Program (DP), and the IB Career-Related Program (CP). With these great programs in place, and access to career and technical training down the hallway at the Kokomo Area Career Center, KHS students have an incredible number of challenging academic programs from which to choose.

Diploma Requirements

KHS students are able to earn a General diploma, Core 40 diploma, a Core 40 with Academic Honors diploma, a Core 40 with Technical Honors diploma, or an International Baccalaureate Diploma. To earn a Core 40 diploma, a student at Kokomo High School must earn 40 total credits including: 8 in Language Arts, 6 in Mathematics (including Algebra I, Algebra II, and Geometry), 6 in Science, 6 in Social Studies, 2 in Physical Education, and 1 in Health. Additionally, the state requires graduates earn a graduation pathway. To earn a Technical Honors diploma, a student must fulfill all of the Core 40 requirements, earn 47 total credits including 6 credits in a career-technical program, and have a minimum GPA of 3.0. Students must also demonstrate college and career readiness through dual credits, assessments, certifications, and coursework. To earn an Academic Honors diploma, a student must fulfill all of the Core 40 requirements, take additional college preparatory coursework (advanced math, foreign language, and fine arts) for a total of 47 credits, and have a minimum GPA of 3.0. Students must also demonstrate college readiness through AP, IB, and/or dual credit courses and exams. To earn an International Baccalaureate diploma, a student must meet the DP requirements set forth by IB.

Advanced Placement

Advanced Placement (AP) courses prepare students for AP tests, which many qualify them for college credit and/or exempt them from freshman-level college courses. AP courses are weighted by adding an additional 1.0 grade point to the grade earned in AP courses on a 4-point scale. Last year, Kokomo High School administered 396 AP tests to our students. Available courses offered at KHS are below. Courses designated with an asterisk (*) were not offered in 2021-2022 or 2022-2023 due to student enrollment or staffing in the course.

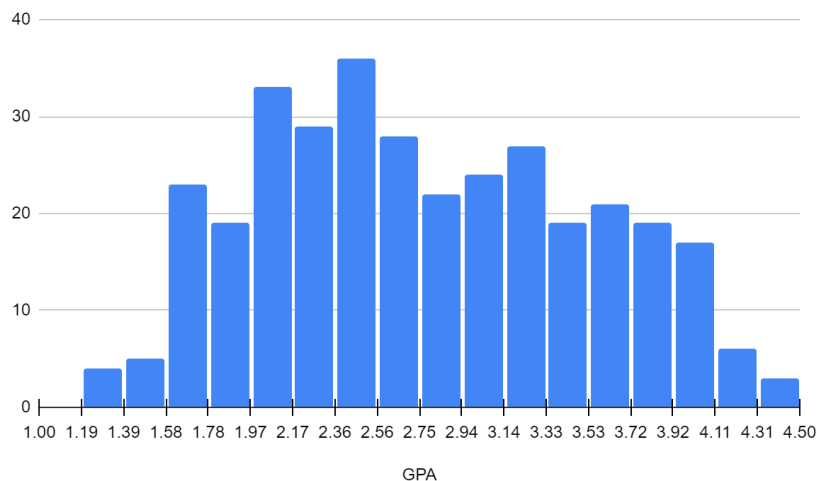
Grading Scale and Class Rank

The GPA is determined by dividing total points by the total number of credits attempted. Grades are weighted for AP and IB DP courses. Weighted grades add an additional 1.0 grade point to a 4-point scale. **We do not rank students.**

- We do not report discipline information to universities or provide ratings on school reports.
- As many schools move toward test-optional or test-free admissions, KHS will not be providing historical data on SAT or ACT scores.
- In 2021-2022, Kokomo High School students took 396 AP exams in 21 subjects.
- KHS students were awarded more than 2500 dual credit hours through partnering universities (Ivy Tech Community College, Indiana University, Vincennes University, and The University of Southern Indiana).
- The class of 2022 was offered more than \$7.2 million in scholarships.
