# REQUIREMENTS FOR ATTENDANCE

- Child must turn 4 years of age no later than December 1
- Parent/Guardian must provide evidence of updated and appropriate immunization and medical information, Proof of Residency and a copy of birth certificate
- Parent/Guardian is required to register child using the SCOPE Eleyo registration system once their child is selected

# SCOPE

## PRE-KINDERGARTEN STAFF

- Teachers are NY State certified with certification in Birth - 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade or Pre-K – 6 grade
- Undergo extensive background check
- Attend mandated training (First Aid and CPR)
- 2 staff members will supervise children at all times



# CURRICULUM

The SCOPE curriculum is aligned with NYS Pre-Kindergarten Standards and offers an imaginative and developmentally appropriate curriculum that encourages not only a child's creativity and social skills, but expands their readiness skills that will be transitional into your school district kindergarten program.
