Please review the following required concert attire for all musicians in the Wantagh Schools.

Boys: black dress pants, long sleeve white dress shirt, tie, and dark dress shoes.

Girls: black skirt* or pants, $\frac{3}{4}$ or full sleeve white blouse, and dark dress shoes or dress sandals.

*all skirts must be below the knee while in a seated position

Please note: no jeans, sneakers, noisy jewelry, or flip flops are permitted.

This mandatory concert dress will be strictly adhered to at all Wantagh Schools concerts. Students will not be permitted to perform unless they are dressed appropriately. There will be a limited supply of approved clothing available for students to borrow for the evening if they arrive to the concert in the wrong attire.

All our music students work incredibly hard in order to prepare for their concerts, and we want to ensure that their dress reflects the maturity and excellence they have achieved in their musical endeavors.
