

# Policy “JCDA” Smoking/Use of Tobacco

Grades 1-3

## Violation

*Any student grades 1-3 who is found guilty of possessing, using, or distributing any tobacco product, smokeless tobacco, or any smoking object/device, including but not limited to electronic cigarettes, advanced personal vaporizers, vape pens, vape mods and similar devices on School Board property or during any school-approved function, shall be subject to the following consequences for such violations.*

## Recommended School Action

### Possessing:

#### **1<sup>st</sup> Offense**

- **Confiscate;** investigate to determine the reasoning for having the item in possession; invite parent(s) in for conference; issue warning; sign contract that indicates consequences and makes reference to only bring school supplies; reminder of 100% tobacco/drug free zones

#### **2<sup>nd</sup> Offense**

- **Confiscate;** investigate to determine the reasoning for (2x) offense; parent conference; violation of contract- **3-day detention/ISS**

#### **3<sup>rd</sup> Offense**

- **Confiscate;** investigate to determine the reasoning for (3x) offense; parent conference; violation of contract – **1-day OSS**

#### **4<sup>th</sup> Offense**

- **Confiscate;** investigate to determine the reasoning for (4x) offense; parent conference; violation of contract – **3-day OSS**

### Using

#### **1<sup>st</sup> Offense**

- **Confiscate;** investigate to determine the reasoning for using; parent conference; place on contract that indicates the next consequence and makes reference to only bring and use school supplies; student may be referred to cessation counseling services; **3-day detention/ISS**

#### **2<sup>nd</sup> Offense**

- **Confiscate;** investigate to determine the reasoning for (2X) offense; parent conference; student may be referred to cessation counseling services; violation of contract **1-day OSS**

#### **3<sup>rd</sup> Offense**

- **Confiscate;** investigate to determine the reasoning for (3X) offense; parent conference; refer to cessation counseling services; violation of contract - **3-day OSS**

#### **4<sup>th</sup> Offense**

- **Confiscate;** investigate to determine the reasoning for (4X) offense; parent conference; refer to cessation counseling services; violation of contract - **5-day OSS**

# Policy “JCDA” Smoking/Use of Tobacco

Grades 4-5

## Violation

*Any student grades 4-5 who is found guilty of possessing, using, or distributing any tobacco product, smokeless tobacco, or any smoking object/device, including but not limited to electronic cigarettes, advanced personal vaporizers, vape pens, vape mods and similar devices on School Board property or during any school-approved function, shall be subject to the following consequences for such violations.*

## Recommended School Action

### Possessing:

#### **1<sup>st</sup> Offense**

- **Confiscate;** Investigate to determine the reasoning for having the item in possession; Make contact with parents to inform and gather additional information; Provide instructions on the harmful effects of using such products; Place on universal district contract that indicates consequences and firm reminder to only bring school supplies; Reminder of 100% tobacco/drug free zones; **Three (3-day) detention / ISS**

#### **2<sup>nd</sup> Offense**

- **Confiscate;** Investigate to determine the reasoning for having the item in (2X) possession; **one day OSS** – violation of contract

#### **3<sup>rd</sup> Offense**

- **Confiscate;** Investigate to determine the reasoning for having the item in (3x) possession; Contact parents; **three (3-day) OSS** – violation of contract

#### **4<sup>th</sup> Offense**

- **Confiscate;** Make contact with parents to inform; Violation of contract-**30 day Suspension to alternative site.**

### Using

#### **1<sup>st</sup> Offense**

- **Confiscate;** Investigate to determine the reason for being in possession and using the product/device; make contact with parents to inform and gather additional information; **3-day OSS;** place on a contract that indicates the next consequence and that makes reference to bringing only those supplies necessary for school purposes; student may be referred to cessation counseling services.

#### **2<sup>nd</sup> Offense**

- **Confiscate;** **30-day Suspension to alternative site;** may be referred to cessation counseling services.

#### **3<sup>rd</sup> Offense**

- **Confiscate;** Recommended for expulsion (05) for **one semester** (86 days) with a review for early release; student must meet criteria for release (Token Reinforcement Level System--to include good attendance, good grades and no disciplinary infractions); Released and placed on probationary contract; student may be referred to cessation counseling services

#### **4<sup>th</sup> Offense**

- **Confiscate;** Recommended for expulsion (05) for **one complete semester;** No Early release option; student must meet criteria for release (Token Reinforcement Level System--to include good attendance, good grades and no disciplinary infractions); released and placed on probationary contract; student shall be referred to cessation counseling services

Violation	Recommended School Action
<p><i>Any student grades 6-12 who is found guilty of possessing, using, or distributing any tobacco product, smokeless tobacco, or any smoking object/device, including but not limited to electronic cigarettes, advanced personal vaporizers, vape pens, vape mods and similar devices on School Board property or during any school-approved function, shall be subject to the following consequences for such violations...</i></p>	<p><b>6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup></b></p> <p><b>1<sup>st</sup> Offense</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Confiscate; 15-day suspension to alternate site; Student may be referred to cessation counseling services; Drug tested; No hearing</b></li></ul> <p><b>2<sup>nd</sup> Offense</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Confiscate; 30-day suspension to alternate site; Student may be referred to cessation counseling services; Drug tested</b></li></ul> <p><b>3<sup>rd</sup> Offense</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Confiscate; recommended for expulsion (05) for one semester with a review for early release and placed on probationary contract; Student shall be referred to cessation counseling services</b></li></ul> <p><b>4<sup>th</sup> Offense</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Confiscate; recommended for expulsion (05) for one complete semester; no early release option; student must meet criteria for release (Token Reinforcement Level System--to include good attendance, good grades and no disciplinary infractions); Released and placed on probationary contract; Student shall be referred to cessation counseling services</b></li></ul> <p><b>9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup></b></p> <p><b>1<sup>st</sup> Offense</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Confiscate; 30-day suspension to alternative site; May be referred to cessation counseling services; Drug tested</b></li></ul> <p><b>2<sup>nd</sup> Offense</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Confiscate; recommended for expulsion (05) for one semester with review for early release; student must meet criteria for release (Token Reinforcement Level System--to include good attendance, good grades and no disciplinary infractions); released and placed on probationary contract; student may be referred to cessation counseling services; Drug Tested</b></li></ul> <p><b>3<sup>rd</sup> Offense</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Confiscate; recommended for expulsion (05) for one complete semester; no early release option; student must meet criteria for release (Token Reinforcement Level System--to include good attendance, good grades and no disciplinary infractions); Released and placed on probationary contract; Student shall be referred to cessation counseling services; Drug Tested</b></li></ul> <p><b>4<sup>th</sup> Offense</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Confiscate; recommended for expulsion (05) for two complete semesters; no early release option; student must meet criteria for release (Token Reinforcement Level System--to include good attendance, good grades and no disciplinary infractions); Released and placed on probationary contract; Student shall be referred to cessation counseling services; Drug Tested</b></li></ul>
