

**NORTH COLLINS CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT
BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES**

Kind of Meeting: Annual Meeting and Canvass of Vote

The Annual School District Meeting of the qualified voters of North Collins Central School District, Erie County, New York, held at the North Collins Central School gymnasium, 2045 School Street, in the Town of North Collins, New York, in said School District on the 17th day of May, 2022, at 12:00 Noon, Daylight Savings Time, was called to order.

CALL MEETING
TO ORDER

Permanent Chairman, Kathleen A. Mason, called the meeting to order at 12:00 Noon, Daylight Savings Time, and announced that the purpose of the meeting was to vote upon the Annual School Budget for 2022-2023, a proposition for the Purchase of School Vehicles, a proposition for a Capital Improvements Project, and the election of two (2) Trustees on the Board of Education.

Inspectors of the Election then reported that prior to the opening of the polls each voting machine to be used at the meeting had been examined, that all counters were set at zero (0), that the ballots were properly labeled, and that each machine was, in all respects, in proper condition for use.
