Dear Waterford High School Families,

School starts in less than a week – I hope you are all looking forward to it as much as I am! Here are some final reminders and details to help make sure you are ready:

- **Bell Schedules:** The bell schedules for the 2022-23 school year are attached to this message. We will start the day in Advisory on Wednesday and Thursday, then switch to our regular daily schedule on Friday. We will end the first week of school with an ice cream social in the courtyard. - **Books and School Materials From Last Year:** If you still have any books or other school-issued materials (except for Chromebooks) from last year at home, please bring them with you on Monday and return them to the second floor office. We need them to use with this year's classes.

- **School Meals for 2022-23:** Waterford Public Schools has opted in to the School Meals Assistance Revenue for Transition (SMART) funds providing meals (breakfast and lunch) at no cost for all students at the beginning of the school year. [School Meals 2022-23 SY.pdf](#)
- **Parking Permits:** Students driving to school can pick up a parking permit application in the second floor office. Students will be permitted to drive to school the first week of school prior to getting a permit for the year. If you are driving to school, remember to give yourself some extra time in the morning, as traffic can be heavy at the start of the school day.
- **Picture Day Information:** Schoolgraphics (Frausini Photography) will be taking school pictures on Wednesday, September 7th and Thursday, September 8th. We encourage all students to have their photo taken even if you are not planning on purchasing a picture package. This helps us keep an updated photo in PowerSchool.
- **Back-To-School Night:** Our parents open house will be on Thursday, September 8th, starting at 5:30 pm in the auditorium. After a 30 minute greeting from the high school administration team, the evening is an open-house format from 6:00-7:30 pm where you can visit the teachers you wish to in the order you prefer.
