

Request for Proposals – Camden County School System

Project Name: Camden County High School Gutter/Downspout Improvements

The Camden County School system is accepting proposals for gutter improvements using 24ga. Prefinished galvalume 6" Box Gutters and 4"x 4" downspouts. The below outlines the project:

- Removal of existing damaged gutters and downspouts.
- Disposal of all removed materials and any other debris.
- Furnish and install box gutters and downspouts as described above.
- Downspouts must be installed and connected to drainage system in place.
- Warranty for materials and workmanship for at least one year.
