Midterm exams are mandatory. Students must remain for the entire exam period and should bring appropriate materials to read if they finish their exam prior to the end of the period. Buses will pick students up at 12:10 p.m. on all mid-term exam days, January 18th, 19th, 20th, 23rd, and 24th. Cell phones and smart devices are not allowed during exam sessions. Seniors taking semester courses may be exempt from a midterm exam with a grade of 90 or above at the teacher's discretion.

Students with an unexcused absence from an exam may not make up the exam. See attendance policy #6006 for what qualifies for an excused absence. A parent or guardian must provide a written note to report a student absent, the reason, and call **860-489-2294 ext. 2151**. Students who miss an exam due to an excused absence must contact their teacher to arrange for a makeup exam. Please refer to the exam schedule for available make-up sessions.

Lunch will be a grab-and-go after the last scheduled exam. Students must be present in school only when they have a scheduled midterm exam. Students who attend school and who are not in an exam session must remain in the cafeteria.

In the event of inclement weather: Snow days that occur during the exam period - the exam(s) scheduled for that day will be held the first-day school reopens, and all other exam days will follow in order.

Late openings: 2-hour delay - The first exam session will begin at 9:30 a.m. and conclude at 11:40 a.m. The second exam session will begin at 11:50 a.m. and end at 2:00 p.m. Buses will run at 2:10 p.m.

It is my hope that the remaining school year will be a good one for all our students. Together, we can help students achieve academic success.
