

4 YEAR OLD KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM PHILOSOPHY

The Hayward School District believes that every child in the Hayward Community School District has a right to a quality age appropriate four year old program. **All community children that are four by September 1st will be allowed to participate in the four year old program.** Every child will be treated with an attitude of respect and care.

The 4 year old kindergarten program will use the Wisconsin Model Early Learning Standards and Creative Curriculum as a guide for classroom focus. The classroom teachers will strive to create an environment which stimulates creativity and learning for the children.

The 4 year old kindergarten program values the family-school connection and encourages parents to attend parent-teacher conferences, parent outreach activities, and to volunteer in their child's program.

4 YEAR OLD KINDERGARTEN CURRICULUM

The goal of our four year old curriculum is to create an environment that promotes learning and social skills appropriate for our four year olds. Children learn by doing. They use all of their senses to explore and get information. Each child will be given the opportunity to learn at his/her own pace and in the way four year olds learn best.....through play. What looks like play has been planned by professionals to develop specific skills that your child will need for later school years. Your child's program will include the following types of activities:

- Social/Emotional
- Daily Living Skills
- Language and Literacy Development
- Creative Expression
- Movement

ELIGIBILITY

Students participating in the 4 year old kindergarten program must be four years of age by **September 1st**. There will be no early admissions. Participants must be residents of the Hayward Community School District. For more information, contact the Hayward Primary School at (715) 638-9201.

4 YEAR OLD KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

To register your child for the 4 year old kindergarten Program, stop by the Hayward Primary School at 10665 N. Main Street Hayward, WI to pick up the paperwork. **Registration begins in February.**

Materials to bring with you for the registration appointment include:

- A birth certificate for the child/children being registered
- Immunization records for the child being registered
- Current medical physical examination documentation
- Registration forms

**Note: It is strongly recommended that your child be toilet trained prior to coming to 4 year old kindergarten.*

FAMILY OUTREACH PROGRAM

An important component of the 4 year old kindergarten program is the Family Outreach Program. The focus of the program is to provide parents and children with opportunities to grow as a family. Throughout the school year activities and presentations will be open to families with four year olds. The 4 year old kindergarten classrooms will provide about one activity per month supporting the educational and social development goals of the research-based Creative Curriculum program.

TRANSPORTATION

The goal of 4 year old kindergarten is to always provide the safest transportation for the children. Children needing to be transported on a school bus will be provided the same bus service contracted for the regular District busing. We advocate and support the safest transporter of four year olds to be the parents. If at all possible, we encourage parents to do the transporting of their child.

HAYWARD COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT BUS DROP OFF OF KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS POLICY 751.4

In the interest of safety of our kindergarten or younger students, the Hayward Community School District requires that a parent or responsible person be present to receive or pick up a kindergarten or younger student from a school bus stop.

ATTENDANCE

It is an expectation that children enrolled in 4 year old kindergarten will attend every day school is in session. Regular attendance at the four year old program establishes healthy patterns of attendance that can last throughout the school years and into adult employment.

If students are going to be absent from school for any reason, parents are required to phone in the absence to the school prior to or on the day of the absence. Please inform the school of your child's name and the reason for the absence. Attendance is taken every day, prompt notification of absences helps keep the record keeping accurate. A child's absence is designated as "excused" or "unexcused."

Excused absences include illness, medical and dental appointments, and certain family situations. Generally, as long as a parent/guardian calls in to inform the staff of the absence, it will be considered excused.

An unexcused absence is generally the result of the child simply not attending class and the parent/guardian not notifying the staff of the absence.

STUDENT RECORDS

Student records are maintained to assist school personnel in determining educational experiences for each student. The District recognizes the need for the confidentiality of student records. "Student Records" are defined as relating to an individual student. The 4 year old kindergarten classrooms will have regular communication with parents/guardians regarding your child's progress.

CONFIDENTIALITY

Each family has the right to their privacy being respected and enforced. The school district will help maintain privacy in the following manner:

- Student records will not be left out for others to view.
- Parents and staff are not allowed to discuss children and families with other parents.
- Staff will not discuss children and families with other staff unless there is a direct benefit to the family and child involved.
- Parents are asked not to talk about incidents observed in the classroom or at any other activities that involve children other than their own.

NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY

No person shall, on the basis on handicap, race, color, national origin, religion, sexual orientation, or gender, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any education program or activity in the Hayward Community School District. PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES

Communication between the parents and the 4 year old kindergarten teachers is of utmost importance. Each 4 year old kindergarten classroom teacher will schedule at least two parent/teacher conferences throughout the school year to share the progress of your child.

FIELD TRIPS

Classes may periodically take field trips to local points of interest during the year. Field trips are planned to coordinate with themes studied by a class or to take advantage of special community events. Your permission will be required for trips that require riding a bus.

SCHOOL CLOSINGS/DELAYED OPENINGS

4 Year Old Kindergarten will follow the District's school closings/delayed openings. Parents/Guardians will be informed by the school website, radio and/or TV if school is to be closed due to extreme or hazardous weather conditions. Occasionally there may be a delayed opening or early closing because of weather conditions. This will also be announced on the following radio stations:

IMMUNIZATIONS

Students are required by Wisconsin State Law to be immunized against certain contagious diseases. The school is required by state law to enforce the immunization requirements. The school seeks the cooperation of parents in ensuring that their child is properly immunized before they attend school.

Any student not meeting state mandated immunization requirements can be excluded from the school for up to 10 days. A student entering the Hayward Community School District has a full school year, plus 30 days into his/her second year to meet the requirements, before exclusion would occur.

During the first year legal notices are sent out at state mandated intervals to all parents/guardians of noncompliance. After three (3) notices, if the student is still not compliant with required immunizations, that student's name is sent to the District Attorney for possible legal action. If for some reason a student returns their second year and has still not met the first year requirements, a notice will go to the parent/guardian on the 15th school day and if still not compliant by the 30th school day, that student will be excluded from school.

Parents/guardians do have the option of signing a waiver on immunizations for religious, medical, or personal convictions.
