By-Laws

## **SUBJECT: REPORTING OF EXPENDITURES**

Each candidate for the position of member of the Board of Education whose expenses exceed \$500.00 must file a statement accounting for his or her campaign expenditures and contributions with the Clerk of the Board and an additional statement with the Commissioner of Education. In the event the expenses do not exceed \$500.00, then a sworn statement to that effect must be filed with the Clerk of the Board. The first statement shall be filed ten (10) days before the election. The second statement shall be filed within twenty (20) days after the election. All statements must be sworn before a notary public, a commissioner of deeds, a lawyer or a public official authorized by New York State law to administer oaths.
