

Using PowerSchool to register for classes – for current 8th graders

STEP ONE:

- Look through the Badger High School Course Catalog
- Discuss with your parents the course selection process
- When choosing courses it is important to remember you must have 7 classes minimum each semester. Badger has an 8 period day so if you choose to you can have one study hall per semester
- Please use the registration form to help you complete the process

STEP TWO:

Required classes:

English, Science, Math

- Your current teacher should have put in a recommended class based on your ability, test scores, homework completion, and motivation

Social Studies, Physical Education, Health

- These are required one semester classes. Make sure you choose these when you make your course selection. You must be recommended by your current teacher for AP Human Geography which is a whole year course
- Health and PE will be chosen for you on your account. If you want to take Health in summer school you will have to sign up on the Badger High School webpage. There are only a certain number of seats open so make sure you sign up as soon as possible. If you get into a summer school Health class, the health option on your registration sheet will remain on your selections until summer school is over and the course is passed

STEP THREE:

Elective classes:

Agricultural Science, Business, English, Family and Consumer Sciences, Music, Technology Engineering, Theatre, World Language, Visual Arts all offer electives that can be taken during freshmen year. Please make note that some of these are full year classes and some are one semester. Look these over and make sure you choose your electives wisely. **Once the student schedules are made, there will be no changes made based on lack of interest.**

If you are currently enrolled in a World Language class, make sure your **current** teacher makes a recommendation for what level you should sign up for. Music classes may require an audition and your music class may change after you complete the audition process.

STEP FOUR:

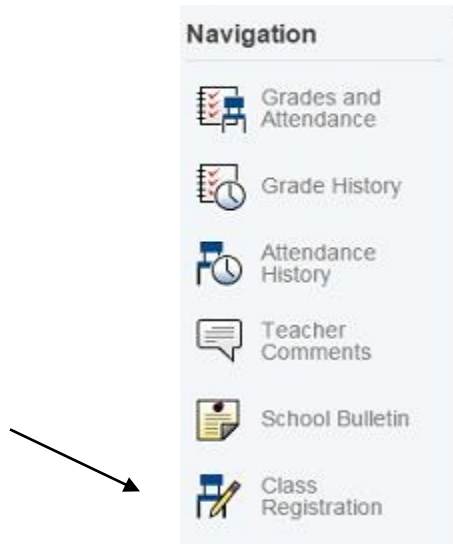
Alternate Classes:

List four alternate classes you would be willing to take in place of your intended courses if needed. Sometimes elective classes are too popular and have too many students sign up for them making them full. Other times elective classes do not take place due to lack of interest and sometimes two classes are offered at the same time and you are unable to be in both classes. In all of these situations you will be

placed in one of your alternate selections. **Please make sure you choose alternates wisely as a schedule will not be changed because you no longer have interest in the class.**

Begin the Class Registration Process

- Logon to PowerSchool
- On the main menu, click **Class Registration**. You will see a screen similar to the one below

To remove a course, simply click the selection box to turn the check mark OFF

- Click on the **OKAY** button when you have completed your selections for EACH group



Once you select a course it will be displayed back on the main selection screen
