

**RESOLUTION DECLARING THE IMPRACTICABILITY
OF TRANSPORTATION AND OFFERING PAYMENT
TO PARENTS IN LIEU OF TRANSPORTATION**

Resolution No. 10.01.2019-01

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 3327.02 provides a process that allows a board of education to determine that it is impractical to transport a pupil who is eligible for transportation to and from school under Section 3327.01 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3302.10, the Superintendent of Public Instruction established an Academic Distress Commission of the Youngstown City School District ("District"); that the Academic Distress Commission has appointed the CEO to lead the Youngstown City School District during the implementation of an Academic Recovery Plan; that the CEO has complete operational, managerial and instructional control of the District and the responsibility and authority to act for the Board of Education and Superintendent of the Youngstown City School District during the period of Academic Distress; and

WHEREAS, the District Chief of Transportation has considered the factors set forth in Ohio Revised Code Section 3327.02 related to the transportation of the below listed students; and

WHEREAS, the following factors as identified in Revised Code §3327.02 to be considered by the CEO:

1. The time and distance required to provide the transportation
2. The number of pupils to be transported
3. The cost of providing transportation in terms of equipment, maintenance, personnel, and administration
4. Whether similar or equivalent service is provided to other pupils eligible for transportation
5. Whether and to what extent the additional service unavoidably disrupts current transportation schedules
6. Whether other reimbursable types of transportation are available; and

WHEREAS, based on the recommendations of the Chief of Transportation, the CEO has determined that transportation for certain pupils is impractical and, therefore, authorizes payments in lieu of transportation.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the CEO of the Youngstown City School District as follows:

The CEO determines in accordance with the factors to be considered under Ohio Revised Code Section 3327.02 that it is impractical to transport the following students to and from school and, therefore, the CEO authorizes the payment in lieu of transportation, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3302.10, to the parents/guardians of the below identified students.
