## **RESOLUTION OF THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER**

**June 10, 2020**

### **RESOLUTION NO. 06-10-20-04**

#### **TO DECLARE THE DISTRICT WILL NOT PROVIDE CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION SERVICES TO GRADES SEVEN AND EIGHT DURING THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR**

**WHEREAS**, The Superintendent of Public instruction, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3302.10, established an Academic Distress Commission for the Youngstown City School District, which Academic Distress Commission appointed a Chief Executive Officer ("CEO") to lead the District during the implementation of an Academic Recovery Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the CEO has the responsibility and authority to act for the local board of education and superintendent of the District during the period of Academic Distress; and

**WHEREAS**, during this period of Academic Distress, where language in Ohio Revised Code Chapter 33 or any other provision of Ohio law refers to the "board of education" or "board" or "superintendent," the CEO shall have the authority to act, which authority shall remain with the CEO as long as the District remains under Academic Distress; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 3313.90 of the Revised Code, public school districts must provide career technical education to seventh and eighth grade students; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the aforementioned statute, a public school district may obtain a waiver from the Ohio Department of Education by adopting a resolution which provides that the district will not provide career technical education for grades seven and eight; and

**WHEREAS**, the Youngstown City School District desires to obtain said waiver.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the District hereby determines that career technical education will not be provided for grades seven and eight in the 2020-2021 school year.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the CEO's designee is hereby authorized to take whatever steps necessary to submit this Resolution to the Ohio Department of Education on or before September 30, 2020, and to otherwise obtain the waiver requested herein.

On June 10, 2020 this resolution was considered by the Chief Executive Officer.
