

Principles and Objectives for Community Relations

Successful education programs require the support of the school district community. The School Board addresses the importance of the role of the school district community in the school district in this series of the policy manual.

The School Board recognizes this support is dependent on the school district community's understanding of participation in the efforts, goals, problems and programs of the district.

In this section, the School Board sets out its policies defining its relationship with the school district community. In striving to obtain the support of the school district community, the School Board will:

- Provide access to District records
- Inform the school district community of the district's goals, objectives, achievements, and needs
- Invite the input of the school district's community, and
- Encourage cooperation between the district and the school district community

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
