Get Ready to Learn

- Quiet space free from distractions
- Computer fully charged or plugged in
- Materials accessible
- Eat breakfast/ Use the bathroom

Lesson Time

- Log in ontime for each lesson

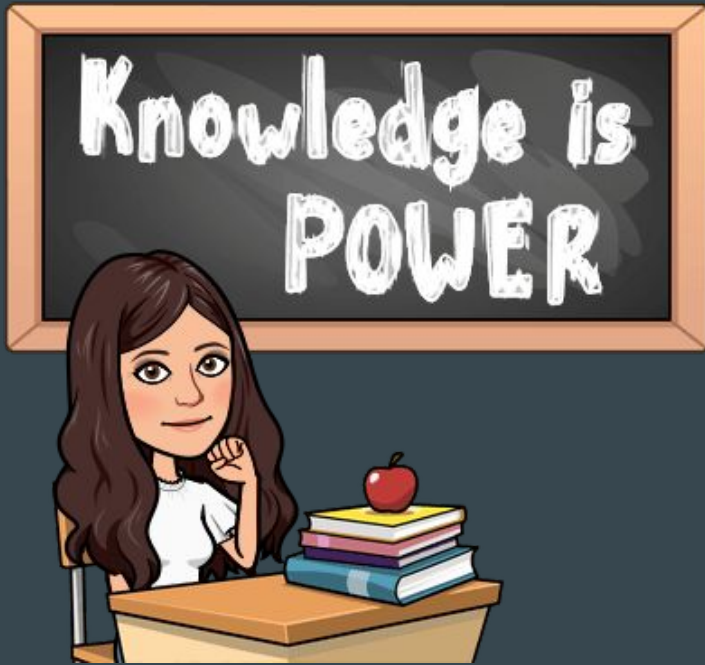

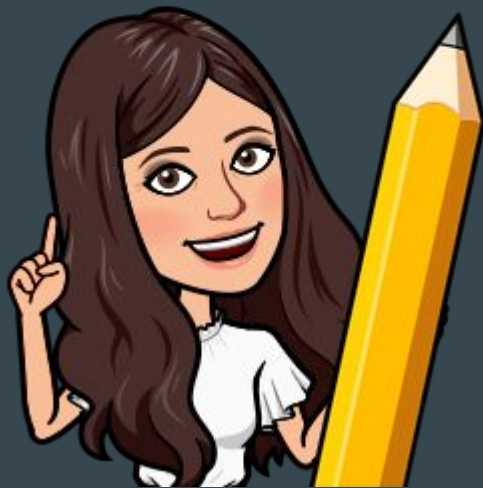
