During Term 4, school staff will soon be determining if a student will earn promotion to the next grade level, attend the promotion ceremony, BBQ/Field Day, and attend the 8th grade dance.

**\*\*All school dress and behavior codes apply to all activities\*\***

**June 10th:** Invited Grade Eight students will participate in an after-school dance in our café-atorium from 5:30 pm to 8:30 pm. Each year we request that students dress appropriately for this celebration. Our intention is to have students look nice for their last get together, without causing families any great expense. This is NOT a prom.

**June 14th:** Invited Grade Eight students will participate in a cookout/field day on school grounds during the school day.

**Criteria to attend the dance and the BBQ are:**

- No more than three (3) conduct referrals for the period 5/10/22-6/10/11
- No suspensions for the period 5/10/22-6/10/22
- Administrative discretion/approval regarding overall student behavior and conduct referrals.

***June 16th:*** You are cordially invited to the 8th Grade Promotion Ceremony to be held here at Normandin Middle School on Thursday, June 16th at 8:30am in the gymnasium. This special event marks the last time our Grade 8 students will gather together to celebrate both individual and class accomplishments.

To make the promotion ceremony special for your child, please adhere to the following:

- All students report to their homeroom at the usual time of 7:50am; the ceremony will begin at 8:30am.
- Two family tickets will be issued to your student.
- Parking is reserved for parents on the north side of the building adjacent to the cafetorium/fields and on the adjacent streets.
- The Orleans entrance (back of school) will be open for you to enter at 8:00am.
- Please make flower and balloon presentations after the ceremony.
- Please remain in your seat until all students have filed out at the conclusion of the program.
- Students will either be dismissed from school at the end of the promotion ceremony with written parent/guardian permission (attached) or have the option to stay in school until the end of the day.

We take seriously our responsibility to provide appropriate support and guidance as students prepare for high school and a changing, increasingly complex world. As such, we believe it is important to hold students accountable for their academic achievement, attendance, and behavior. Invited students who are able to self-manage and have met the academic criteria will be able to attend the promotion ceremony. **Computers and chargers must be turned in before the ceremony in order to receive certificates.**

***Eligibility requirements for the ceremony:***


- No core failures (ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies) for the year

- No more than three (3) conduct referrals for the period **5/10/22-6/15/22**
- No suspensions for the period **5/10/22-6/15/22**
- Administrative discretion/approval regarding overall student behavior
