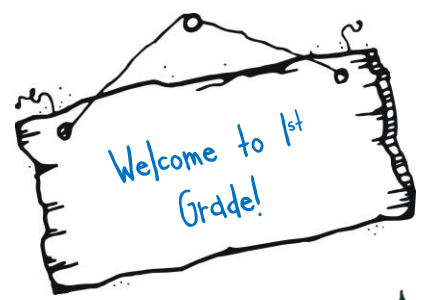




Meet Mrs. Ferrara

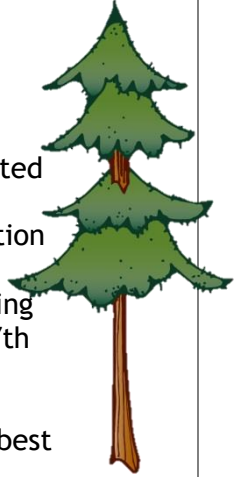


about me
